Re: Thank You and Request to Sign Support Letters to Fund FY 2019 HUD Programs by April 13th

Dear Senator Harris:

On behalf of the California Housing Partnership, thank you for your leadership in obtaining a 10% increase for HUD programs in FY 2018. While FY 2018 omnibus takes an important step in addressing the nationwide shortage of affordable rental housing, as our <u>latest report on the state of need in California</u> shows, there is much more to be done.

Specifically, we also ask you to express your support for the following FY 2019 funding levels for these important HUD programs:

- \$22.8 billion for Housing Choice Vouchers and \$2.8 billion for McKinney-Vento Homeless
 Assistance Grants by signing-on to the <u>Senate letter</u> which your staff can do by contacting <u>Meredith Booker</u>
- \$5 billion for the **Public Housing Capital Account** and to fully-fund the **Public Housing Operating Account** by signing-on to the <u>Senate letter</u> which your staff can do by contacting <u>Rebecca Schatz</u>
- \$12.2 billion to renew existing Project-Based Rental Assistance (PBRA) contracts for the
 calendar year by signing-on to the <u>Senate letter</u> which your staff can do by contacting <u>Meredith</u>
 Booker or Rebecca Schatz
- \$619 million for renewal funding and \$210 million for capital advance and project-based rental
 assistance awards for the Section 202 Housing for the Elderly program, and \$313 million for the
 Section 811 Housing for Persons with Disabilities program by signing-on to the Senate letter
 which your staff can do by contacting Rebecca Schatz
- \$3.5 billion to support the **Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)** by signing-on to the <u>Senate letter</u> which your staff can do by contacting <u>Kelsey Daniels</u> or <u>Brent Palmer</u>
- \$1.5 billion for the **HOME Investment Partnerships Program** by signing-on to the <u>Senate letter</u> which your staff can do by contacting <u>Kelsey Daniels</u> or <u>Brent Palmer</u>
